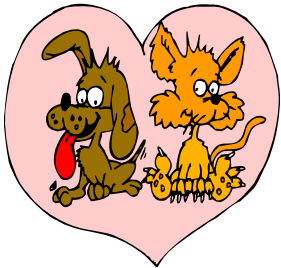

Art Auction for the Animals



The Sylvan Learning Center located at 2246 N. University Drive (on the southwest corner of University and Royal Palm) is hosting "Art Auction for the Animals". The date of this event is Sunday, November 7th from noon to 5pm. All proceeds (100%) from the auction will go to the Tri-County Humane Society, a no kill shelter located on Boca Rio Rd.

Sylvan is requesting donations of art from local artists and residents that have an animal (including bird, reptile or fish) theme. The artwork can be photographs or paintings, framed or unframed. There will be a silent auction as well as a live auction. The donations need to be dropped off at Sylvan by Monday, November 1st during the hours of 7pm-10:30pm. FLORIDA ATLANTIC UNIVERSITY FINE ARTS FESTIVAL

The Department of Visual Arts and Art History at FAU is scheduled for Saturday, October 9th and Sunday, October 10th from 10am to 5pm at the Visual Arts Center and Schmidt Center Gallery public space on the Boca Raton campus. The festival will feature the art and design work of FAU students and professional artists. All the artwork is for sale with prices ranging from \$10-\$10,000. All proceeds from the sale of student artwork benefits the students and academic programs of the Department of Visual Art and Art History. In addition, the festival will have 10 Artist Talks each day, tours of the Visual Arts Center Studios, theater and musical performances, open university galleries, food and beverages.
