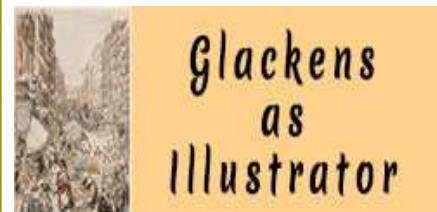

## CSMART CALL FOR ENTRIES—SNOWFLAKE EFFECTS



The Coral Springs Museum of Art is seeking entries depicting scenes of the winter season or outdoor winter weather. Works of two dimension originals (no Giclees) will be selected for artistic conceptualization, mastery and technique. The artwork must be 36" or less for outside dimensions, including professional framing (free of damage or wear) or 1.5" finished gallery wrap. All work must be properly wired for hanging and should include screw eyes. The artist name, title, medium and artist contact information must be clearly labeled on the

back of the work.

The exhibition dates are November 23, 2013 to February 1, 2014. Entry deadline is September 27th by 5 PM. Accepted works will be based on merit by a panel of museum professionals. Notification of acceptance will be October 11th by email. Artists must deliver their accepted works to the museum on November 9th from 10am to noon. The Museum reserves the right to refuse any works that do not meet the criteria as outlined in the prospectus.

There is a non-refundable entry fee of \$40 for up to two pieces of artwork. Exhibited artwork must be labeled with the selling price or NSF (not for sale). A commission of 30% is payable to the Museum for works sold during the exhibition so the sales price should include the cost of the commission. The entry form which is available on the CSAG website must be emailed to the Museum no later than September 27th at 5pm to [Jandrews@coralsprings.org](mailto:Jandrews@coralsprings.org). The entry form must include a jpeg or pdf image of 4x6 inches and no more than 1200x1200 pixels. The file size of each image must be no larger than 2MB.

The entry form, artwork labels and information on pickup, the contract, artist responsibility, publicity and liability are available at [www.coralspringsartistguild.com](http://www.coralspringsartistguild.com) website.

The Sawgrass Nature Center and Wildlife Hospital which is located at 3000 Sportsplex Drive in Coral Springs is a non-profit facility that is wholly dependent on their fundraising efforts. Their annual Gala is November 9th at Heron Bay in Parkland. They are asking local artists to consider donating art pieces, paintings or prints for them to auction at the Gala. 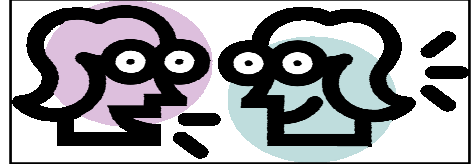
